## REQUIREMENTS TO TAKE ACC DUAL CREDIT CLASSES

The State of Texas requires that students meet certain testing score requirements in order to be eligible to take college-level classes. Students must meet one of the exemptions below or have passing scores on the TSI test in order to take dual credit courses.

Students can use scores from different tests to qualify for dual credit classes in different subjects. For example, a student can qualify for math classes through their math SAT score, and English classes through their reading and writing TSI Assessment scores.

## **Need to take the TSI test?**

Check in the College and Career Center (room 133) for scheduled test dates. If you are not able to make it on these days or if you do not pass and need to retake it, you will need to go to an ACC campus to test.

## **What you need to do BEFORE taking the TSI test:**

- Log onto <http://sites.austincc.edu/tsiprep/> and complete the Pre-Assessment Activity.
- Print the Certificate of Completion and bring it with you when you take the TSI test.
- ***YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY if you are taking the TSI test at Anderson.***

## **What do I do after I complete this form?**

- Bring this form with attached score report (ACT, SAT, TSI, etc) to room 133 for further instruction.

## **How to take the TSI Test at an ACC campus:**

- Go to [www.austincc.edu](http://www.austincc.edu)
- Highlight **Admissions** near the top of the page
- Click on **Apply Now**. Follow instructions and submit application.
- After 24 hours, you should receive an email with your ID included.

  - Click Students at top of page
  - Click **ACCeID** on right side of the page
  - Click **Activate ACCeID** and follow instructions on the page, including create a password & answers to security questions

- Follow the 3 steps listed.
- **Step 3** will give you **locations for testing** (<http://www.austincc.edu/admissions/tsi-assessment/tsi-assessment-schedule>) and the days/times the test is offered at each location.
- When testing at the ACC Assessment Center, please be aware:
  - Drop in testing is permitted at some locations -seating is not guaranteed. Call the location to confirm.
